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#### **SECTION 1: UM COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT GRANT SCHEME**

#### 1.1 Preamble

The Universiti Malaya Community Engagement Grant Scheme aims to change the culture of Universiti Malaya (UM) research to be more community centred through offering specific grant, matching fund, and program. This grant scheme is to manifest on how closely UM through UM Community Engagement Centre (UMCares) works with the society through community-engagement projects, strategic targeting of demographic groups within the community, and by strongly involving community members in our projects. This community engagement grant strategically positioned the UMCares to link important factors to produce impactful social-change. Important resources' links within the university to academic professionals, students, volunteers, grants, and funds as well as links outside the university to community members in need, key stakeholders, experts, and government bodies are effectively exchange resources by optimising benefits to the community. In short, UMCares is a branch of UM which is wholly dedicated to benefiting the community through strategic and well-implemented projects.

We welcome proposals that are manifestly aligned with UMCares strategic aim and supports any of project cluster which are sport and recreation, social welfare, entrepreneurship, environmental development, ICT and technology, rural development, education, health, national and cultural heritage conservation. Other considerations include generation of research impact, knowledge transfer, catalysing further progress for existing action research to achieve multifarious social impact and the sustainability of the project. From the national perspective, achieving the Shared Prosperity Vision 2030 is the archetype for this grant objective to benefit key targeted communities as listed in the vision's polarity management. The grant also would like to call for research projects that align with themes and policy enablers of the Twelfth Malaysia Plan as well as the Framework of the 10-10 MySTIE and Malaysia Education Blueprint 2015 – 2025 (Higher Education). At the international gradation, the Universiti Malaya Community Engagement Grant is strategically aligned to United Nation's seventeen (17) Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

We focus on functioning model of Partnership Matching Fund (PMF) where our role is to incentivize and sustain the keen interest and aim of our collaborators, construct their capacity to lead, strategize, and give unrestricted opportunity to policymaking. Not only for our collaborators, empowering the targeted community's capacity to manage solutions by solving issues relevant to the community needs is also the prime effort harnessed from this grant. Apart from the community engagement grant and matching fund, community engagement program also being offered under this scheme, namely Nadi Lembah Pantai and Kelab Sahabat. These programs have unique application process and criteria but remain the same in focusing the grant area as listed in the national priority areas as well as the nine (9) UMCares Project Clusters.

# **SECTION 2: UM COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT GRANT**

# 2.1 UM Community Engagement Grant

#### 2.1.1 Introduction

UM Community Engagement Grant funds for action research that is conceptually applying multi / inter / trans-disciplinary research as analogous to other grants, i.e., UMRG, IIRG, etc. This grant can be funded for existing research to further testing application of their research's output to community. The project leader or applicant who has active collaboration with organisation as project partner or stakeholder will be prioritised to be awarded. Organisation or stakeholder that will be a collaborator to the project can be an entity that support a social cause and must be a registered company or association that possess revenue source (annually audited) which able to maintain their social mission. Applicants are allowed to be applicant members to other application but not eligible to be a project leader for another project at the same time.

Project that focusses to these communities will be underscored to secure the grant; B40 group, poor and economically vulnerable, community in economic transition, indigenous community, person with disabilities, youth, women, children, and senior citizen. Project activities that promote initiatives addressing issues on economic empowerment and social re-engineering as well as targeting new beneficiary community by providing innovative solutions to existing issues may be supported from this grant.

- To implement research output to the community through action research.
- To empower community through community engagement and impacting the nation.

## 2.1.5 Grant Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Open to all Universiti Malaya academic staff as project leader: Associate Professor, Senior Lecturer, and Lecturer with permanent or contract status.
- 2. Academic staff as project leader with contract status, a minimum appointment of twelve (12) months is required and the applicant members of the project must involve at least one (1) permanent academic staff.
- 3. Proposed project must be interdisciplinary in nature and involve at least two (2) communities benefited from the project (as listed in the polarity management of Shared Prosperity Vision 2030).
- 4. Proposed project with three (3) or more communities as project beneficiaries AND three (3) or more collaborators (organisation) will be prioritised to be awarded.
- 5. Project application that shows evidence of active engagement with collaborators and stakeholders at the time of project application and throughout the project will be prioritised to secure the grant.
- 6. Proof of university-organisation collaboration must be provided together with monetary and non-monetary contribution that will be involved for the proposed community engagement project.
- 7. Project can be a delivery of research output that is ready to be applied and benefiting community.
- 8. Proposed project must at least show the capability and readiness to change community knowledge, behaviour, skills and aspiration parallel to 3 stars rating for Networking & Linkages, Malaysia Research Assessment (MyRA).
- 9. Proposed project must able to demonstrate short and middle-term impact in the national priority area throughout project exposition (maximum 12 months) and sustainable in scalability and replicability.
- 10. Proposed project must deliver a sustained output (module, resources, etc.) to community for solving the community issues and betterment of the community livelihood.

# 2.1.6 Grant Non-eligibility Criteria

- 1. Fund from organisation that is sponsored directly to applicant as individual fund or donation is not allowed for this project grant activities.
- 2. Project proposal that is supporting political agenda as part of initiatives to benefit target communities as specified in point 2.1.4 Grant Area will not be considered for proposal evaluation.
- 3. Profit-making, charitable purposes and faith-based project proposal is not eligible for this grant application.
- 4. Project proposal that is focusing on funding for physical amenities, equipment, refurbishment of working area and equivocal as initiative to solve community issues will not be considered for proposal evaluation.
- 5. Project activities bearing cost for bank charges, guarantee costs, debt services charges, provision for future liabilities, contribution as in kind, cost for fine, penalties, and litigation expenses are not allowed.



# **SECTION 3: UM PARTNERSHIP MATCHING FUND**

## 3.1 Partnership Matching Fund

#### 3.1.1 Introduction

The Partnership Matching Fund (PMF) is a matching fund provided by UMCares to researchers who receive funds from local agencies / industries and therein named as organisation, to carry out community projects that will benefit the community listed in the polarity management of Shared Prosperity Vision 2030 as similar listed in the UM Community Engagement Grant.

Project leader who received funding from local organisation and interested in applying PMF must send in application to UM Community Engagement Centre (UMCares). Application can only be processed after the recipients and Universiti Malaya had successfully received funding from the relevant organisation. Approvals are subjected to panel's decision and upon successful PMF application, the fund must be administered by Universiti Malaya via UMCares.

## 3.1.2 Fund Objectives

To encourage UM researchers to source out local organisation grants for community project or program and to strengthen the university collaboration with external partners

## 3.1.3 Fund Eligibility Criteria

- 1. This fund is open to all UM researchers who are successful in securing funds from local organisation (government/ agency/ industry) grants.
- 2. Applicant and project criteria as listed in point 2.1.5 Grant Eligibility Criteria and 2.1.6 Grant Non-eligibility Criteria.
- 3. Organisation to be partnered for funding the project should be unequivocal in capability to be the project collaborator.
- 4. Project leader and applicant members should be competence in skills for knowledge transfer and able to deliver expected measurable output and outcome.
- 5. Project leader who receives funding from UMCares (active project) is not entitled to apply.

#### 3.1.4 Quantum of Funding

Matching to partnership fund is applied to a ratio of 3:1 (organisation fund: PMF fund). PMF is funding to a maximum of RM 20,000 for grant received from an organisation with an amount of not less than RM10,000 per project. The amount awarded will depend on the availability of funds.

# 3.1.5 Scope of Funding

The funding can be utilised for the following vote categories which are exactly related to the project:

#### 3.1.6 Fund Duration

UM Nadi Lembah Pantai program is an initiative by UM through UMCares to approach community particularly those residing near UM. The program as a platform to communicate directly with the community representative to identify issues and stakeholders, e.g., school, industry, etc. to develop research mapping. On the development of this Lembah Pantai community ecosystem, replication will be applied to other community ecosystem near UM, i.e., Kampung Tunku, Petaling Jaya and Damansara. UM Nadi Lembah Pantai is a holistic program involving all UM community (academic staff, non-academic and student) from various responsible centre in UM. This program is focusing on three focus area:

- Health and Well-Being
- Education
- Environment

Other than these areas are also covered, subject to the community issues and suggestion by UM researcher. Target communities for this program are children, youth, adult, and senior citizen. This program also aiming to close the gap among the economic status group of B40 and T20.

To provide platform for UM community to collaborate with Lembah Pantai community, local industry, government agency, and non-governmental organisation.

#### 4.2. Kelab Sahabat

This program opens to all UM academic staff to conduct action research with UMCares school network, i.e., school adoption program named as Kelab Sahabat. This program has started since year 2016 engaged through a memorandum of understanding between UM and Pejabat Pendidikan Daerah (PPD) Petaling Utama. This program is focusing on area addressed by the school community and suggestion by UM researcher. On the development of this school community adoption, replication will be applied to other PPD near UM, i.e., Pejabat Pendidikan Wilayah (PPW) Bangsar / Pudu.

# 4.2.2 Program Objectives

To support school community in Klang Valley through national school curriculum and co-curriculum via knowledge transfer program.

## 4.2.3 Program Eligibility Criteria

- Following general criteria provided in Section 2 and Section 3: UM Community Engagement Grant and Partnership Matching Fund (PMF) respectively.
- Minimum 5 schools of Kelab Sahabat to participate per program. Schools in the district of Petaling Utama will be nominated by PPD Petaling Utama following the program targeted area and criteria.
